## SAINT ANTHONY JUNIOR SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

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For more than 158 years, St. Anthony Junior Senior High School has served the people of Maui County and Hawaii under the guidance of members of the Sacred Hearts Order, Society of Mary, Marianists, Maryknoll Sisters, and the St. Joseph Sisters of Carondelet orders.

St. Anthony High School has an excellent reputation for maintaining high academic standards. During its sesquicentennial history, more than 15,000 students have graduated from this school. Many furthered their academic pursuits by earning degrees from institutions of higher learning and have established themselves in a variety of professional careers internationally.

The people of Maui recognize the positive contributions our students have made to improve the professional, economic, cultural and moral fabric of our island society. The spirit of community service encouraged at St. Anthony's has also generated the devotion of invaluable time to countless community projects and volunteer work by our students and graduates.

# Our History

Saint Anthony's commitment to the young people of Maui began in a one-room schoolhouse erected in 1848 by the Sacred Hearts Mission Fathers on the grounds of Saint Anthony Church. The Marianists opened Saint Anthony Boys School in 1883. Staffed by the Sisters of Saint Francis of Syracuse, Saint Anthony Girls School was founded a year later. In 1968, the two schools merged creating a co-educational high school. Saint Anthony became a junior, as well as senior, high school in 1972 with the addition of grades seven and eight.

Today, Saint Anthony Junior Senior High School is Maui's Catholic High School. It collaborates with the Diocese of Honolulu, Saint Anthony Parish, and the Society of Mary (Marianists) in providing a Catholic education for young men and women in the Marianist tradition.

# Campus Ministry

Saint Anthony Junior Senior High School provides various opportunities dedicated to the development of the spiritual dimensions of its students. Headed by the Campus Minister in collaboration with students from the school's L.I.F.E team and Campus Ministry club, the department seeks to strengthen the spiritual and apostolic atmosphere of the school.

Some of the activities of Campus Ministry include: school masses, prayer services, student and faculty retreats, vocation days, apostolic ministries, programs for those interested in the Catholic faith, small Christian communities for students and faculty, and the development of Christian leaders. Campus Ministry personnel is also available for spiritual counseling and mediation.

## L.I.F.E.

The Saint Anthony L.I.F.E. (Living In Faith Experience) program includes our neighbor island schools of Saint Joseph, Hilo; Saint Louis and Sacred Hearts on Oahu, as well as Marianist schools in California: Archbishop Riordan High School in San Francisco, and Junipero Serra High School and Chaminade Preparatory High School in Los Angeles.

Moderators, along with ten to twelve students from each school meet in California or Hawaii to share ideas on how to enhance the spiritual development of their school through many activities and projects initiated by the L.I.F.E team.

# Academics

Accredited by WASC, the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, Saint Anthony Junior Senior High School provides a college preparatory and comprehensive general education curriculum of the highest quality. We pride ourselves on our counseling and library services. Our student/teacher ratio is about 1:15, and over 98% of all Saint Anthony graduates continue on to college.

Although the majority of Saint Anthony student complete more, a minimum of 56 semester credits are required for graduation. Students must successfully complete the following courses to graduate:

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**To complete the requirements,** Advanced Placement, Honors, and College Early Admit courses are available providing students meet the established prerequisite. To graduate from Saint Anthony Junior Senior High School, a student must earn a minimum of fifty-six credits. Each term course earns one credit. Student must successfully complete all required courses to receive the Saint Anthony diploma. Those students who pursue a college preparatory program should increase various requirements such as math, foreign language, and science to be accepted at many colleges and universities. In addition many colleges are requiring a year of fine arts and technology classes.



The school day begins at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 2:45 p.m., except on 1st and 3rd Thursdays when the students are excused at 12:40 p.m. All the students are required to wear uniforms and be enrolled in a minimum of seven classes per semester.

The academic year is divided into two semesters. There are three progress reporting periods within each semester which allows for frequent communication on the progress of each student. Saint Anthony offers advanced placement and honors courses, and makes available courses through Maui Community College.

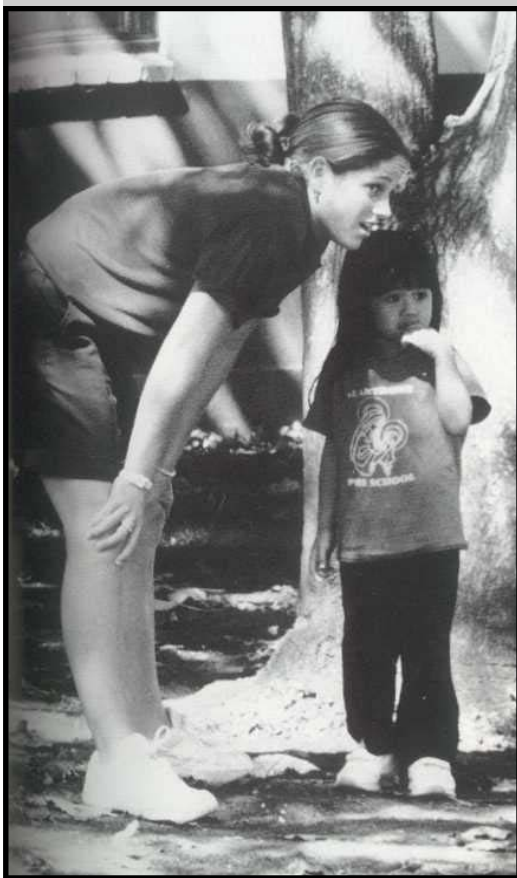

# Community Service

# Technology

Saint Anthony Junior Senior High School is proud to highlight the addition of two new media/learning center in the Bishop Sweeney Memorial Library. The completion of these two centers represents almost \$500,000 of volunteer time and generous donor contributions, and brings the total computer count on campus to over 200 within four computer lab-media/learning centers, a video conference center, and at least one computer in every classroom.

Besides introductory classes in computers, Saint Anthony offers several levels of Computer Application programs, including Object Oriented Programming for our advanced students. Many of these classes are student directed which means that the students work at their pace and are able to move up as they reach their maximum potential at each level.

Each faculty, staff, and student is given an email account with the Saint Anthony Junior Senior High School network. This helps provide better communication between and within our 'ohana. Computer workshops are also offered to faculty, staff, and parents.

Saint Anthony Junior Senior High School also utilizes the K-12 Program. This program allows parents to log onto the Web and keep up with the progress of their student(s). Grades, behavior, assignments, and teacher comments for each student in each class are updated weekly.
